This letter is to notify you that Pharmacia & Upjohn Company LLC (a subsidiary of Pfizer Inc) has completed the decontamination and decommissioning (D&D) activities for Building 172 (includes the incinerator system and north tank farm - NTF) at 7000 Portage Road, Kalamazoo MI (Manufacturing Complex). The results of the D&D activities summarized in the enclosed final report, demonstrate that the impacted building & systems are suitable to release for unrestricted use, in accordance with 10 CFR 20 Subpart E and Pfizer NRC license requirements Item 10.5. As documented in the Final Status Survey report, residual activity levels are essentially equal to natural background levels.

Pfizer contracted Safety and Ecology Corporation (SEC) to perform the D&D activities in accordance with the D&D Plan submitted to the NRC Region III – Decommissioning Branch on March 15, 2007. The D&D Plan was based on the Multi-Agency Radiation Survey and Site Investigation Manual (MARSSIM) and Pfizer's site decommissioning procedures.

In addition, Pfizer is requesting an amendment to eliminate Building 172 from the existing byproduct material license number 21-00182-03. Building 172 was approved by our Broad Scope Type A License as a location of use but not specifically named on the license. The current plan is to remove and recycle the incinerator equipment and tanks from the NTF yet retain Building 172 for future use.
