SUMMARY OF MANAGEMENT ACTIONS And STATISTICAL ANALYSIS FOR REPORTING PERIOD January THROUGH June 2007

The average eligible population was randomly tested at a rate of 55% during the reporting period.

The total positive tests for this period were 5; these were pre-access, short-term contractor personnel that accounted for the positive tests. Additionally, 5 short term contractors refused to test during the pre-access processing. These 10 individuals were denied access at CPNPP.

TXU Generation Company LP (Luminant Power) submitted blind performance specimens in accordance with 10 CFR 26, Appendix A, Section 2.8 (e)(2), requirements. There were no reportable events.
