Attached is an amendment request to revise the Security Plan for SNM-1168 for the purpose of constructing a permanent chemistry building. The proposed Security Plan changes, identified below, will afford AREVA NP Lynchburg an improved construction process and minimize the affect that construction activities may have on current facility operations. The purpose of the new Chemistry building is to expand our capacity for conducting our current chemistry processes.

Enclosure (1) is an updated Security Plan which only reflects the change of the name of our facility from Framatome ANP, Inc. to AREVA NP, Inc and adding an additional gate. Enclosure (2) provides an Addendum to the Security Plan for the construction phase of the new permanent chemistry building.

Following construction, we will submit an amendment request to update the Security Plan to reflect the completed Chemistry building and remove the Addendum listed in Reference 2 above.
