I am responding on behalf of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) to your letter addressed to Chairman Dale E. Klein, dated May 13, 2008. In your letter, you stated "I am filing a 2.206 petition on behalf of Pilgrim Watch as the only means available to address safety concerns over the present contract negotiations between Entergy Nuclear Northeast and U.W.U.A. local 369." You requested that NRC require Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station (PNPS) to cease operations if a strike by Utility Workers Union of America, Local 369, were to occur because replacement workers would jeopardize safe operation of PNPS. Your letter was referred to the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation (NRR) for consideration pursuant to Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Section 2.206.

On May 15, 2008, the Petition Review Board considered your petition request and made an initial recommendation that your request did not meet the criteria for consideration under 10 CFR 2.206, because you did not set forth facts which constitute a basis for the requested action. Although you asserted that PNPS could not be safely operated by replacement workers in the event of a strike, you did not provide any facts to indicate why the intended replacement workers might not operate the plant safely. Ultimately, your concern about safe operation of the plant by replacement workers did not materialize because a new four year contract agreement between union workers and management at PNPS was ratified on May 23, 2008, and averted a strike.
