Summary: Mr. Silber reported that an AN-UDM-2 device containing 5 sources of strontium 90 totaling 180.36 mCi has been lost. The device was shipped and received at Balad, Iraq and then shipped to Taji, Iraq. The unit that was to receive the device reported that they didn't receive it and it was not located. Two other units were shipped at the same time but have been received. The licensee believes that the device is in the warehouse but was misplaced.

I asked Mr. Silber to inform me when they locate the device or when they issue a final closure on its status.
