Dear Chief, Rules and Directives Branch:

My wife and I just read in the Lake Anna Observer about the hearing for the Dominion COL application for a third nuclear reactor. I am pleased that our elected officials appear to be representing the majority of Virginians that see nuclear power as the most efficient and environmentally safe method of providing future energy needs.

As a homeowner with lakefront property less than two miles away from the nuclear power plant at Lake Anna, I don't believe that "LACA" or "Friends of Lake Anna" speak for most lakefront homeowners or us. These two groups seem to ignore the real threats to the environment at Lake Anna, while continuously trying to delay or hinder the development of nuclear power at the lake.

All homeowners at Lake Anna, including ourselves, were fully aware that the lake was created to provide a cooling system for the nuclear power plant. It is immoral for "Nimby's" (Not In My Back Yard) to try to hinder that planned development through "activist" delaying tactics. We have complete trust that the federal and state environmental and nuclear regulatory authorities combined with the responsible actions of a regulated utility will balance the recreational, nuclear utility requirements, and environmental concerns to come to an optimum balance. Whatever solutions are arrived at will be better, if interference from anti-nuclear activist groups (posing as environmental groups such as "Friends of Lake Anna") is "taken with a grain of salt".
