Subject: Purpose of request to amend the license.
(NOTE: This will be used as the Documents Title in ADAMS)

Summary: I spoke to Mr. Hannig about the licensee's letter dated May 27, 2008, requesting an amendment to its license. In order for its customer remove from installation and ship the gauge, the general licensee must do so in accordance with the labels affixed to the gauge 10 CFR 31.5©(3)(i). If the licensee is not a specific licensee or the label does not authorize the activity, then the customer can not remove the gauge from installation and ship it to the licensee. The amendment request can not be expedited because the application dated December 1, 2004, requires the licensee to submit a radiation safety program if it were to possess license material at its location in New Jersey. I referred Mr. Hannig to NUREG-1556, Vol. 12 for the information that would be required. Mr. Hannig stated that he would have to speak to his superiors in Germany to determine if they would proceed with the amendment request. I stated that I would contact him in two – three weeks to determine if the action should be voided.
