

## PROGRAM SCOPE

This licensee was an 80- bed hospital, specializing in mental health. The license employed one full-time nuclear medicine technologist. Due to declining business, the hospital decided to cease all licensed activities in March 2008. The licensee performed its last diagnostic nuclear medicine study on March 31, 2008. All doses and calibration sources were transferred to an authorized nuclear pharmacy in April 2008. A close out survey of the nuclear medicine department was performed in April 2008. The licensee provided a copy of the hospital's amendment request dated April 10, 2008, requesting termination of its NRC license. However, the inspector's in-office review of ADAMS showed no amendment request on file. In addition, MLB confirmed no pending amendment request was on file for this licensee. The inspector provided additional FAX nos. to the licensee so that it could file its termination request ASAP.

This inspection consisted of interviews with licensee personnel, a review of select records, tour of the nuclear medicine department, and independent measurements. The inspector also confirmed that the licensee no longer possessed licensed materials. \* Inspection frequency reduced in accordance with MC 2800 due to the licensee's "in active" program.
