The Army Research Laboratory(ARL), Aberdeen Proving Ground (APG), Maryland will soon cease operations in one of our Depleted Uranium (DU) use areas and wishes to decommission the facility at that time.

Building 1103A was a facility that assembled and disassembled targets that had been used in tests that involved DU. The facility has both fixed and removable contamination inside the building and minor contamination in the soils around the facility. Several small outbuildings also show contamination.

I have enclosed a copy of the Decommissioning Plan (DP) in both hard copy and electronic form. The DP was prepared by Cabrera Services, Inc. and draws heavily on experience learned in preparing the DP form for ARL's Range 14 DP. Cabrera has agreed to meet with you to discuss further details or supply additional information.
