Dear Mr. Clark

This is in reference to your application dated April 29, 2008 requesting Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information. Please provide this information as soon as possible. You may fax your signed response to 610-337-5269, referencing mail control 142358. When you send the fax, you may wish to leave a voicemail or e-mail message to alert me to look for it.

1. On a detailed version of your facility diagram please provide the information listed below.
 - a. Indicate which rooms are restricted and unrestricted as defined by 10 CFR 20.1003, and provide room numbers.
 - b. Describe methods used to ensure security of the hot lab (i.e. lockable door is locked when hot lab is unattended).
 - c. Specify what is located above and below the hot lab.
2. You have requested that Lee S. Anthony, PhD., be named Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) on your license. It appears that this individual may be an outside consultant\contractor. If this is so, in support of this request, please address the following:
 - a. Describe the control over the radiation safety program that will be delegated so that the consultant-RSO will be able to exercise authority over authorized users when confronted with radiation safety problems that require implementation of corrective actions.
 - b. Describe the relationship that will exist between the consultant-RSO and your institutional management regarding expenditure of funds to facilitate the objectives of your radiation safety program and related regulatory requirements.
 - c. Identify other commitments of the consultant-RSO for other NRC or Agreement State licensed facilities, along with a description of how the consultant-RSO will allocate time to permit the performance of the duties of the RSO as described in the regulations. State the consultant-RSO's minimum amount of on-site time (hours per week).

- d. Appoint an in-house representative who will serve as the point of contact during the RSO's absence. This person may be allowed to assist the consultant RSO with limited authority.
 - e. Describe the overall availability of the consultant-RSO to respond to questions or operational issues that arise during the conduct of your radiation safety program and related regulatory requirements. Specify the maximum amount of time it will take the RSO to arrive at the facility in the event of an emergency that requires his presence.
3. It appears that your proposed authorized users, Drs. Donna and Robert J. Sefczek, may not be on-site during licensed activities. Describe the supervision and training Drs. Sefczek will provide to ensure that licensed material is handled in accordance with his instructions (10 CFR 35.67).
 4. On your application, Nelson Travis Clark is listed as the certifying officer. Please submit a Curriculum Vitae detailing Mr. Clark's previous employment and training history.
 5. Please provide a business license to show that you have been registered as a legitimate business entity in the state of Virginia.

Please note that you may not reply to this letter by return e-mail. Your reply must be in writing by letter or facsimile (610-337-5269). If we do not receive a reply from you within 30 calendar days from the date of this e-mail, we will assume that you do not wish to pursue your application.
