

Reference: 1. Letter from Deborah A. Seymour to David Stinson dated April 30, 2008 entitled "MIXED OXIDE FUEL FABRICATION FACILITY-NRC INSPECTION REPORT 70-3098/2008-001 AND NOTICE OF VIOLATION"

In order to allow additional time to complete cause analyses and develop corrective actions plans for violations identified in Reference 1, Shaw AREVA MOX Services (MOX Services), requested by telephone, a thirty day extension to respond to the violations. Condition Reports (CRs) have been issued by MOX Services to document the causes and corrective actions. The extension request was granted by Deborah A. Seymour on May 27, 2008 in a telephone conversation with Noël Simpson of MOX Services.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.201, and the thirty day extension, MOX Services will provide a response to the violations identified in Reference 1 by June 29, 2008
