Tues, April 29<sup>th</sup> – Gaffney, South Carolina – on-site tours of the Lee site and agency interface meeting;  
Wed, April 30<sup>th</sup> – Charlotte, North Carolina – documentation review at Duke offices; and  
Thurs, May 1<sup>st</sup> – Gaffney, South Carolina – open house (5-7p) and public meeting (7-10p) at Gaffney High School.
