As we discussed earlier today, I am sending you information regarding the NRC's site audit and public scoping meeting related to the Lee Nuclear Station in Cherokee County. A quick breakdown of the week's activities is provided below and a more detailed schedule is attached.

Tues, April 29th - Gaffney, South Carolina - on-site tours of the Lee site and agency interface meeting; Wed, April 30th - Charlotte, North Carolina - documentation review at Duke offices; and Thurs, May 1st - Gaffney, South Carolina - open house (5-7p) and public meeting (7-10p) at Gaffney High School.
