Enclosed is an application (XSNM3541) received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), dated June 3, 2008, from Mitsui & Co. (U.S.A.), Inc., for the export of low-enriched uranium (LEU) to Japan for initial core loading in the Shimane Unit 3 nuclear power reactor.

Before taking action on this request, we would appreciate your views, in accordance with established procedures and from the overall perspective of the Executive Branch, as to whether the proposed export meets the applicable criteria in the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended.

Please note that the material is of Australian, Canadian, Nigerien, South African and U.S. origin; converted in Canada, France, and the U.S.; enriched in France, the Netherlands, and the U.S.; and re-converted in the U.S. It, thus, has Australian, Canadian and EURATOM obligations.
