To Whom It May Concern:

This facility would like to request an amendment to add another location to our license for mobile nuclear medicine service. All applicable radiation safety procedures will be performed the same as stated in the license that is currently held under 10-CFR-35.

The amendment is to add this location to our license:

River Cities Cardiology 1366 North Gardner Street Scottsburg, IN 47170

The administration of radioactive material and scanning will be performed at this new location.

Radiation safety procedures:

- *A letter signed by myself permitting the use of byproduct material at our new Scottsburg office is enclosed.
- *Radioactive material will be received at the original address for the license.
- *Radioactive material will be taken to above address. Prior to administration, the decay calculation will be performed and written records of actual doses will be kept on file.
- *Instrument used to measure the activity of unsealed byproduct material will be checked for proper function before use at the approved address. This will include at least a dedicated source check of the survey instrument.
- *Temporary "Caution Radioactive Material" signs will be posted during administration and scanning procedures.
- *All waste and radioactive material will be transported back to the original licensed address.
- *Before leaving the above address, after all patient scans have been completed, a survey

- of all areas of use will be performed to ensure compliance.
- *All applicable DOT requirements will be performed such as:
- -Shipping paper completed and retained
- -Surveys of packages as required
- -DOT training for all applicable personnel

Additional information for this amendment:

- 1. A description and diagram sketch of the new location for our mobile service is enclosed. This is actually the anticipated layout of our new facility. If any changes are made once we move in, we will be sure to inform you.
- 2. Radioactive material will be transported in our truck, but not stored there for extended periods of time. These items will be transported to the alternate site: Unit doses of Tc99m or Tl201 products stored in lead pigs provided by Cardinal Health Radiopharmacy, a CO57 flood source stored in a lead carrier, and a Geiger Counter with a CS137 source. The radiation levels in the truck driver's compartment are in compliance with 10 CFR 20.1201.
- 3. Supervised individuals have received the training described in section "Supervision" in Appendix V in NUREG 1556, Volume 9, Revision 2.
- 4. Individuals working in or frequenting restricted areas have received the training described in section "Training for Individuals Working in or Frequenting Restricted Areas" in Appendix V in NUREG 1556, Volume 9, Revision 2 as applicable by our license.
- 5. Survey instruments and dose instrument checks will be performed as described in the section titled, "Survey Instrument and Dose Measurement Instrument Checks" in Appendix V in NUREG 1556, Volume 9, Revision 2.
- 6. Radionuclides will be received at the "base location" located at the Medical Arts Building, 207 Sparks Avenue, Suite 104, Jeffersonville, Indiana.
- 7. Emergency procedures will be followed as applicable to the situation described in the section titled "Emergency Procedures in Appendix V in NUREG 1556, Volume 9, Revision 2.
- 8. The transportation procedures for radionuclides will be followed as applicable as stated in the section titled "Transportation" in Appendix V in NUREG 1556, Volume 9, Revision 2.
- 9. Radioactive Waste handling procedures: All radioactive waste will be stored at the "base location" for decay, not in the truck. Transporting radioactive waste
