Dear Mr. Linton,

In a letter dated October 13, 2009 the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff presented open issues to Uranerz regarding the NRC Nichols Ranch facility Safety Evaluation Report (SER). By this letter, Uranerz is submitting responses to the NRC open issues and confirmatory items. The responses include:

- A detail response to each open issue including reference to the applicable section of the Technical Report for those open issue responses that require revisions to be made to the Technical Report along with supporting information for each detailed response.
- 4 copies of all responses and attachments for the open issues. All attachments have been separated based upon the section of the SER open issue.

Additional information that was not part of the NRC open issue responses has also been provided that includes revisions to Section 2.4 of the Technical Report and Section 3.8 of the Environmental Report. This information was revised based upon conversations with staff regarding the Technical Report Table of Contents and also the concurrent environmental review. These revisions include the following information:


