SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF NRC RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE NO. 49-27065-01

Dear Mr. Skretteberg:

By application dated December 2, 2011, McGarvin-Moberly Construction Company informed the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) that you wished to terminate your NRC radioactive materials license 49-27065-01. The NRC Form 314 dated December 2, 2011 stated that all radioactive material had been disposed by transfer of the material to a NRC licensee.

The supporting documentation to the NRC Form 314 also provided the most recent leak test for the devices authorized under this license. The NRC staff has reviewed the supporting documentation to your NRC Form 314. Based on the documentation submitted and a review of your historical file, the staff concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from the facility and the facility at 1001 Highway 20 North, Worland, Wyoming is suitable for unrestricted use in accordance with 10 CFR 20.1402, "Radiological Criteria for Unrestricted Use." Based on these conclusions, no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required.

Please find enclosed Amendment Number 06 to License Number 49-27065-01, authorizing your license termination. An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(20)(ii).
