SUBJECT: REVISION OF QUALITY ASSURANCE RECORD STORAGE COMMITMENTS
IN PGE-8010, "TROJAN NUCLEAR QUALITY ASSURANCE PROGRAM"

Dear Mr. Quennoz:

By letter dated November 28, 2010, Portland General Electric Company submitted a proposed change to document number PGE-8010, "Trojan Nuclear Quality Assurance Program". The letter explained that Portland General Electric Company proposed to change the media on which a majority of their Quality Assurance records would be stored. The reasons for the change were outlined in Enclosure 1 of the letter.

The NRC has reviewed PGE-8010, proposed Revision 29, and issued Quality Assurance Program Approval for Radioactive Material Packages No. 0327, Revision 16, on December 21, 2011. This approval will satisfy the requirements of Title 10 *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) 71.17(b) and 71.101(c) for a Quality Assurance program approved by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission. In accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 72.140(d), this previously approved Quality Assurance program will be accepted as satisfying the requirements of 10 CFR 72.140(b), except that the licensee shall also meet the recordkeeping requirements of 10 CFR 72.174.
