1/4/2012 (13:15) I left a message on Mr. Merrifield's voice-mail for him to get back in touch with me because the NRC had not, as yet, received an renewal application form the company.

(14:10) Mr. Merrifield returned my call. I informed Mr. Merrifield of the purpose of my call and he stated that he believed that the amendment for the change of ownership completed in October 2011 served to renew the license. I told Mr. Merrifield that the request served as notification of the change of ownership and amended the license for anything that changed with the license. However, nowhere in the request was a statement that the license should be renewed made and, thus, it was considered an amendment. I showed Mr. Merrifield how to access Appendix B of NUREG-1556, Vol. 4 and stated that he could contact me if he had any difficulties in filling out the checklist. Mr. Merrifield asked if he had until December 31<sup>st</sup> to complete the application and I told him that the license expired on January 31<sup>st</sup> while the regulations required the application to be sent in by January 1<sup>st</sup> which was the reason for the courtesy call. The application, once completed, should be sent to the Region I office which I confirmed with Mr. Merrifield.
