**Subject:** Status of your 10 CFR 2.206 petition as of 1/5/2012

Mr. Saporito:

By letter dated 6/28/11, the Director of the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation, Eric Leeds, partially accepted your petition, dated 3/12/2011, filed under 10 CFR 2.206. His letter stated that: *“Although the NRC is rejecting your requests for immediate action, we are accepting your petition to the extent you seek some type of enforcement action in light of the events at Fukushima. Taking into account any findings issued by the task force, the NRC expects to evaluate in the near future whether it should take any enforcement action based on the events you have identified.”* On 10/24/2011, I e-mailed you to inform that the Petition Review Board (PRB) was still evaluating your petition.

The purpose of this e-mail is to inform you that the PRB is continuing to evaluate your petition, and expects to extend the current target date of 1/31/2012 into the future. I shall communicate with you again once that new target date is determined.
