Staff, WTS, and AFS discussed questions pertaining to the liquid penetrant testing for welds on already fabricated packages described in the amendment request sent to staff in a submittal dated December 23, 2011. AFS stated that the multi-pass liquid penetrant testing would be performed only on welds that are on already fabricated packages where radiographic and ultrasonic testing would not be possible due to the corner configuration of the weld. Additionally, the testing would be followed by pressure and leakage rate tests. Staff asked questions on how the weld deposit size is determined in relation to the flaw size. AFS pointed staff to the TRUPACT-II (Docket No. 71-9218) where administratively controlling flaw size was approved. Staff said they would review the drawings and application of that docket. Staff and AFS also discussed possible wording changes found in a note in the drawing pertaining to using liquid penetrent testing. Staff felt that the note's wording was too vague and offered suggestions on how it can improve to be acceptable. AFS said they would submit a revised drawing including a more specific note within the next day.
