By letter dated December 5, 2011, Carolina Power & Light Company (the licensee) applied for amendments to the Brunswick Steam Electric Plant, Units 1 and 2, Renewed Operating License Nos. DPR-71 and DPR-62. The proposed change would have modified the facility technical specifications (TS) pertaining to TS 3.8.1, "AC Sources – Operating," to extend the Completion Time of TS 3.8.1 required Action D.4 for an inoperable diesel generator. Subsequently, by letter dated January 5, 2012, the licensee withdrew the amendment request.
