The NRC is re-issuing our letter to you dated July 25, 2011, which forwarded the results of the subject inspection, in order to provide a version of the letter for public review. During self-assessment activities, the NRC staff identified that, contrary to a statement in its original version, the letter does not contain security related information and can be made available to the public. Please note that only the letter is being re-issued. The inspection report remains unchanged.

On April 25-26, 2011 and July 6, 2011, Craig Gordon of this office conducted a safety and security inspection at the Manchester, Connecticut site of activities authorized by the above listed NRC license. The inspection was an examination of your licensed activities as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's regulations and the license conditions. The inspection consisted of observations by the inspector, interviews with personnel, and a selective examination of representative records. Additional information provided in your correspondence dated May 19, 2011 and May 23, 2011, as related to completion of terms in the NRC Confirmatory Order, dated March 10, 2009 was also examined as part of the inspection. The findings of the inspection were discussed with Mr. Douglas Miskell, Corporate Radiation Safety Officer at the conclusion of the inspection. The enclosed report presents the results of this inspection.

Within the scope of this inspection, no violations were identified. As identified in the inspection report and in the NRC letter to you from William M. Dean, Regional Administrator, dated July 20, 2011, Section V.F. of the Confirmatory Order remains incomplete. The NRC expects Quality Inspection Services, Inc. to complete this item by the end of calendar year 2011, and will continue to assess your activities to comply with the Order.

The Enclosure contains Sensitive Unclassified Non-Safeguards Information. Upon separation, this cover letter is decontrolled.
