It has come to our attention that an error existed in Amendment No. 10 of your NRC Material License No. 24-26333-01. We corrected this error by changing Item No. 6. C. to Californium instead of Cesium.

Enclosed is the corrected copy of your license reflecting the changes we have made. We apologize for any inconvenience these errors may have caused.

NRC's Regulatory Issue Summary (RIS) 2005-31 provides criteria to identify security-related sensitive information and guidance for handling and marking of such documents.
