Subject: Response to NRC Order EA-11-268, Implementation of Additional Security

Measures and Fingerprinting for Unescorted Access for Zion Nuclear Power Station

Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation

In accordance with NRC Order EA-11-268 (Reference 1), Zion Solutions, LLC (Zion Solutions) hereby provides a response to Sections III.B and III.C of the Order in the compliance matrix contained in Enclosure 1. The matrix includes a schedule for achieving compliance with the requirements described in Attachments 1 and 2 of the Order.

Construction of the Zion Nuclear Power Station Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation (ISFSI) is scheduled to begin in Spring 2012 and be completed by December 2012. Transfer of the spent fuel and Greater-Than Class C (GTCC) low level radioactive waste from the Zion Nuclear Power Station to the ISFSI is scheduled to begin in February 2013. In accordance with Section III.A of the Order, draft procedures and plans will be available to demonstrate Zion Solutions' ability to comply with the requirements in Attachments 1 and 2 of the Order by December 20, 2012 or by 90 days before the first spent fuel dry cask storage canister is placed on the ISFSI pad, whichever is earlier. Zion Solutions will inform the NRC Project Manager when the actions discussed in this matrix have been completed and are ready for review and inspection. Implementation of the procedures and plans will be completed prior to placing the first spent fuel dry cask storage canister on the pad.

This letter is decontrolled upon removal from this document. Pursuant to 10 CFR 72.4, Zion Solutions is requesting the NRC withhold Enclosure 1 of this letter from public disclosure as it contains Safeguards Information of a type specified in 10 CFR 73.22(a)(1) and 10 CFR 73.22(a)(4). In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, a copy of this cover letter, when detached from Enclosure 1, does not contain Safeguards Information.
