

<p>On June 20, 2011, I was called by Mr. Proctor in response to my call on June 16, 2011 to follow up on a March 31, 2011 letter to the attention of Natalie Proctor concerning Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant LLC's (CCNPP's) application to renew its NRC license for CCNPP's onsite Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation (ISFSI). The March 31 letter sought information on historic or cultural properties in the area of the ISFSI and to identify any issues with the potential effect of the proposed license renewal on historic or cultural resources.</p> <p>Mr. Proctor left a phone message in which he stated there were two concerns: (1) the aging of the spent fuel, and (2) the aging of the ISFSI. No concerns with historic or cultural resources were identified.</p> <p>With that, the call ended.</p>
