SUMMARY

I informed Ms. Robarge that we had still not received the documents needed in support of their request for termination of the license termination. (She had stated in a telephone conversation in the afternoon of Wednesday, December 28, 2011, that she would transmit the documents by facsimile to the NRC Region III office immediately). Ms. Robarge stated that she faxed the documents to our office this morning. I subsequently checked and the faxed documents had been received, and I informed Ms. Robarge of this, as well as bringing it to her attention that the submitted NRC Form 314 did not appear to be fully completed, in that critical check boxes had not been marked. I also asked her to confirm that radiation surveys had in fact been conducted. She explained that their physicist, Dr. Wierzbicki, had conducted surveys and upon completion took the seeds with him. According to Ms. Robarge, Dr. Wierzbicki informed her that he was scheduled to meet with NRC inspector Andrew Bramnik sometime in January 2012 to discuss the findings and that Mr. Bramnik wanted to see the seeds.

At the conclusion of our conversation, I told her that if I had any additional questions that I would call her back today. She requested that I call the general office telephone number at (810) 667-4000, and that if she happened to be unavailable, to ask for her assistant, Heather.

FOLLOW-UP ACTIONS

The licensee subsequently faxed a revised NRC Form 314 with the additional boxes checked off indicating that all activities authorized by the license had ceased, all radioactive material possessed by the licensee has been appropriately disposed, and that a radiation survey has been conducted and that residual radioactivity was within 10 CFR 20, Subpart E limits and ALARA.

The licensee was contacted with a request to provide the actual survey results. The licensee transmitted a facsimile letter dated December 29, 2011, signed by Jacek Wierzbicki, Ph.D., the Radiation Safety Officer named on the license. In his letter, Dr. Wierzbicki stated that he conducted a radiation survey on December 21, 2011, and that this survey demonstrated no radioactivity and no radiation levels above background.
