On December 19, 2011, Thomas Thompson of this office conducted a security inspection at the above address of activities authorized by the above listed NRC license. The inspection consisted of observations by the inspector, interviews with personnel, and a selective examination of representative records. The findings of the inspection were discussed with you at the conclusion of the inspection

Based on the results of this inspection, the NRC identified a security-related violation(s), which are documented in the enclosed Notice of Violation (Notice). The violation(s) were evaluated in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy and are categorized at a Severity Level (SL) IV. The Enforcement Policy is included on the NRC's website at www.nrc.gov; select **About NRC; Regulations; Enforcement; then Enforcement Policy**. The violation(s) are cited in the enclosed Notice, because the violation(s) were identified by the NRC. Information regarding the basis for the significance determination for the violation(s) is addressed in Enclosure 2.

The NRC has concluded that information regarding the reason for the violation(s), the corrective actions taken and planned to correct the violation(s) and prevent recurrence is already adequately addressed on the docket as summarized in Enclosure 2. Therefore, you are not required to respond to this letter unless the description therein does not accurately reflect your corrective actions or your position. In that case, or if you choose to provide additional information, you should follow the instructions specified in the enclosed Notice.
