Steve,

The Luminant COLA team has reviewed the Chapter 13 Safety Evaluation (SE) with Open Items. We have identified no items which should be exempt from public disclosure and identified no factual errors. We did identify some inconsistencies that eventually need to be resolved and some clarifications which should be provided:

- FSAR Table 13.4-201 and the SE section 13.4.4 which discussed this table refer to FSAR Section 13.8 re the Cyber Security Program. The FSAR does not contain a Section 13.8. The Cyber Security Plan is actually addressed in FSAR Section 13.6. The Cyber Security Plan has not been submitted to the NRC as part of the COLA (Luminant intends to include in COLA Revision 3) but has been provided by letter. Luminant will correct these inconsistencies in a future COLA revision.
- The COLA lists proposed License Conditions in Part 10. The NRC has proposed license conditions in several SE Sections (13.3.2, 13.3.5, 13.8.4.3, 13.8.5 and elsewhere) which are revised from proposed license conditions previously provided by the NRC and which do not match COLA Part 10. Luminant does not concur with the License Conditions as worded in the SE. These inconsistencies need to be resolved.
- In several locations, the SE discusses meeting RG 1.8 and 1.33. CPNPP meets these RGs as discussed in the QAPD. In general the QAPD addresses the use of NQA-1-1994 in lieu of the specific standards referenced by the RGs. We do not feel that this is a conflict but mention it here as a clarification.
- Section 13.8, in various locations, quotes from the Cyber Security Plan which was submitted as an SRI document (See TXNB-11059 dated September 16, 2011 - ML11262A295) and, as such, Luminant requested that the plan not be released to the public. Luminant has examined the quotes in the SE and has determined that, taken out of context, these quotes are not SRI and need not be exempt from public disclosure.
