## REQUEST TO WITHDRAW LICENSE AMENDMENT REQUEST 250, "ADOPTION OF NFPA 805 PERFORMANCE-BASED STANDARD FOR FIRE PROTECTION FOR LIGHT WATER REACTOR ELECTRIC GENERATING PLANTS (2001 EDITION)" KEWAUNEE POWER STATION DOMINION ENERGY KEWAUNEE, INC.

By letter dated September 21, 2011, Dominion Energy Kewaunee (DEK) submitted a License Amendment Request (LAR 250, Reference 1) to adopt National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) Standard 805 (Reference 2) in accordance with 10 CFR 50.48(c).

By letter dated December 16, 2011 (Reference 3), DEK requested NRC postpone the review of LAR 250.
