## Summary

- Order licensees to develop, implement, and maintain guidance and strategies to mitigate the effects of challenges to the key safety functions of core cooling, containment, and spent fuel pool cooling capabilities
- Symptom based
- Procedures, guidelines, and reasonable protection of equipment

### **Basis for Order**

- Uncertainties associated with events such as that at Fukushima are greater than previously considered
  - Need additional defense-in-depth measures
  - Offsite releases and property damage
- Strategies are intended to restore or maintain core cooling, SFP cooling and containment

## Timelines

- Interim Staff Guidance (ISG) by June 30, 2012
- Submit an overall integrated plan including description of compliance within 180 days of issuance of ISG
- Letter when full compliance is achieved, within 2 years of issuance of ISG

# Interim Staff Guidance (ISG)

- ISG to be issued by June 30, 2012
  - NRC provide ISG
  - ISG to endorse industry guidance
  - ISG provides parallel guidance to industry guidance (i.e. RG 1.155)
