Dr. Kolodziej,

Earlier today, I contacted you to confirm that the Order to cease licensed activities will go into effect at midnight tonight, because we do not have a financial assurance instrument yet. Until we receive an adequate financial assurance instrument, you cannot resume licensed activities.

You stated that you plan are working to obtain a Surety Bond, and have gotten real property appraised to support the Surety. As I told you during that conversation (and as was stated in earlier letters and email to you), if you are using a Surety Bond to provide the funding, you also need to establish a Standby Trust Agreement to complete the financial instrument. Most cyclotron licensees that use a Surety Bond and Standby Trust Agreement arrange for both through a bank. You and your insurance agent may want to pursue the bond and/or Standby Trust Agreement with an appropriate bank.

During the call, I also reminded you that you must pay your annual fee. The Fees Branch contact is Mona Williams. She can be reached by email to [Mona.Williams@nrc.gov](mailto:Mona.Williams@nrc.gov) or by telephone to 301-415-7389. Bills and notices were sent to you at the International Cyclotron address during the past several months. If the annual fee is not paid, you will not be able to resume activities under the license.

I also spoke with David Rhoe, your radiation safety officer. He informed us that the cyclotron facility was closed as of February 16, 2012, to ensure compliance with the Order.
