

<b>This conference call was a followup to a public meeting on January 11, 2012. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss a path forward for submission of the high burnup fuel content request that TN plans for the TN NUHOMS-MP197HB. Staff described that the regulations in 10 CFR 71.55 cover loading, transport, and unloading. Staff and TN agreed to use the same approach as that used in the TN-LC review. The approach is that TN demonstrate that there is no safety concern in the event of loss of configuration of the fuel and show that criticality safety is maintained during loading with water present during normal conditions of transport (NCT) and hypothetical accident conditions, and unloading with water present and fuel remaining intact after NCT. TN agreed to show that after NCT, there is reasonable assurance that there is no loss in geometry prior to unloading. This may be accomplished by testing the canister before unloading.</b>				
<b>Staff also stated that a detailed review will need to be made for both high burn up fuel concerns and the moderator exclusion approach. In the January 11 meeting, details were not discussed with respect to TN's moderator exclusion approach.</b>				
<b>TN plans to submit the application by February 24, 2012.</b>
