Dear Gentleman,

I and other Janesville, WI residents will be out of town on the hearing date of February 23rd and/or are unable to participate by the available means listed. I and many others are strongly opposed to this project going forward and to any approval for Shine's experimental project within our city of Janesville, WI. for the reasons listed below. I would ask that our opposition and objections be shared and considered by the nrc officials and entered into the official record.

Opposition points of major objections as follows;

== This is totally experimental, Shine nor the process has any record of operation or success.

== This project has a questionable high risk funding problem and also site & many safety concerns.

== Project was kept secret improperly from the public, between Shine and City officials for two years. Why?

== Project was put on the City Council agenda for a council vote, with less than one week's notice. Why?

== There was no public hearing noticed and scheduled on this project. Why not?

== There was an annexation of land and a TIF district created in conjunction with the proposed project, without proper or adequate notice or procedure, while leaving adjoining TIF land lie vacant. Why?

== The funding proposition has placed a hardship on city funding with its yearly budget shortfalls and increased borrowing, as the city council has now committed for Shine to a \$4,000,000 very high risk loan guarantee of a high risk private loan, with no guarantee, which no one else would back. Why? That is on top of the City giving away another 5 million on behalf of Shine, which we don't have and have to borrow for, etc. Taxpayers are facing a huge risk of very high property tax rate increases from this. Shine is far short of raising the money needed. In my opinion I expect that Janesville will face a financial collapse, if we are saddled with this huge commitment and potential loss of millions.

==Our citizens have not been properly informed on what's involved, what the risks are, how our fine water supply is effected, how much water is needed, air quality risks, what requirements must be met or if the site location can even be approved, or any details of the processes involved in my opinion. It's like buying a 9 million dollar mansion in California sight unseen.

== There was no professional approach at all from Shine or the City, only a questionable last minute secret sneak attack with no prior information presented to the citizens in my opinion.

== There is already another similiar isotope project by North Star, beginning in Beoit, WI, just 12 miles south of Janesville. Two similiar nuclear like projects that close together should never be allowed by the State or Federal nrc regulators. That would pose a substantial environmental risk to our great underground aquifer, from which the whole area gets it drinking water, as well as polution risk to Rock River running through Janesville and the entire nearby Rock River basin.

== There would have to be several testing & filtering stations installed in both the sewer and water piping systems both inside and outside the facility property, and kept separate from general city sewer discharge to the waste treatment plant miles away. if this goes forward. Any haszardous waste, release or exposure & cleanup must not be a City expense.

==Any such facility would have to be built to withstand a fuel loaded cargo plane crash into it, without any invasive damage to the facility, that would expose contamination.. That is because it would be right across the highway from the airport and planes fly directly overhead many times every day. The worst location. There are residences within about 1000 feet. A large pheasant farm has close land all around and any contamination leaks or waste would put that large corporation out of business. Certainly this facility location would not be in an ideal more remote location as desired by nrc.

== Its very strange that such a commitment has been started and nobody knows what is required, how it operates, etc. Shine does not seem to know, the city officials don't seem to know and certainly the residents of Janesville don't really know a thing about this whole project. It was kept secret from citizens for some unknown reason. Is Shine possibly connected with North Star isotope in Beloit, WI.? Maybe a two-pronged permitting process to see if nrc approves at least one? Should not this whole project been previewed by the nrc to see what basic site requirements need to be met first? It appears somewhat under false pretenses, or cart before the horse in my opinion, by apparently secretly getting commitments from city officials

Please do not give Shine any approvals to begin or go forward until all facts and regulations are clearly insituted and defined for all. Please do not allow two of

these facilities to be built in our community. I would also like to be informed of the content and results of the Feb 23rd meeting, and be kept informed of the process and requirements Shine must follow.

Thank you for the opportunity to express our deep concern and strong objections to this experimental nuclear isotope facility.
