I know that the nrc is very concerned with uranium by-[product waste, storage and long term danger and problems, as are the citizens of Janesville and the surrounding area. So my question is, why would you approve, permit and license such dangerous outdated, expensive technology as Shine proposes, that we are all trying to get beyond?

Please do not allow this outdated Shine project and its already outdated technology and endanger the best farm land and drinking water in the nation, right here in Rock County, when we already will have a much safer isotope facility with far less danger only 12 miles away from Janesville. We have food and dairy and pheasant farms all around. In my opinion approving Shines uranium produced isotopes would be irresponsible, when isotopes can be produced much cheaper, safer and much less waste by-products, including no uranium waste.

Shines needs to develop similar product processes as Beloit's Northstar Medical Technologies, without using expensive uranium in its production. with all the inherent problems. Another point is that Northstar had already proved their production method with successful production run, where shine has no proof that their outdated methods would even work. We don't want to be a dangerous production, storage and dumping area of hazardous & nuclear waste in the richest soil and dairyland in the world., here in Rock County. Check it out.
