**AREVA NP Inc. Notification of Errata to XN-NF-85-67(P)(A) Revision 1.**

AREVA NP Inc. (AREVA NP) has identified a documentation error in the approved topical report XN-NF-85-67(P)(A), Revision 1, "Generic Mechanical Design for Exxon Nuclear Jet Pump BWR Reload Fuel," September 1986. A proprietary errata sheet that corrects the documentation error is enclosed. This letter will serve as notification to the US NRC of the documentation error and the correction to that error.

The error was only a documentation error and does not impact any codes, methods, or analysis results. The documentation error existed only in the proprietary version of the report so there is no change to the non-proprietary report and no non-proprietary errata is enclosed. Therefore, the enclosure is considered proprietary in its entirety.

AREVA NP Inc. considers the material contained in the enclosed documents to be proprietary. As required by 10 CFR 2.390(b), an affidavit is enclosed to support the withholding of the information from public disclosure.

- (e) The information is vital to a competitive advantage held by AREVA NP, would be helpful to competitors to AREVA NP, and would likely cause substantial harm to the competitive position of AREVA NP.

The information in the Document is considered proprietary for the reasons set forth in paragraphs 6(b), 6(d) and 6(e) above.

7. In accordance with AREVA NP's policies governing the protection and control of information, proprietary information contained in this Document have been made available, on a limited basis, to others outside AREVA NP only as required and under suitable agreement providing for nondisclosure and limited use of the information.

8. AREVA NP policy requires that proprietary information be kept in a secured file or area and distributed on a need-to-know basis.
