Subject: RAI, License Update

I called Mr. Mayo to obtain some additional information. The proposed RSO's contact information Fax is 860-660-9125, email jvaughn@sikorsky.com. Mr. Vaughn should also be made an authorized user. I told Mr. Mayo that he needed to send in leak tests for sources that were in the 351 Morgan Lane, West Haven, CT facility. He said that there were hundreds of sealed sources that went through the facility and that it was impractical. He also stated that they never had a leaking source. I told him to document that, to give examples of leak tests that were performed that went through the facility in order to get it removed. I told him according to the sealed source and device registry that the IBIS system was now model GNI 122XX IBIS and the only sealed source was IPL or Amersham Model GNI 12205 and asked if the other sealed sources listed on the license could be removed. He said he would review to determine if they could be removed. I also discussed that the Safety Light Corp. Model LAB 785 had a maximum source activity of 3.3 curies. He gave me a different sealed source and device registry NR-1286-D-101-G to review. We also discussed that Sundstrand was now Honeywell International Inc.

Action Required: Mr. Mayo is to send in leak test examples and confirmation of no leaking source. I am to review SS&D NR-1286-D-101-G to determine maximum source activity.
