Dear Mr. Razo:

DMS Health Technologies, ("DMS") holds the above-referenced radioactive material license.

I recently contacted your office to verify what DMS should do in the event DMS' parent company wanted to sell its stock ownership of DMS to another entity. You indicated DMS should provide your office written notice of the pending sale using a prescribed NRC format. I have attached the required documentation to this letter.

As I have noted on the attached form, DMS' parent company, Varistar Corporation, is proposing to sell 100% of its stock ownership in DMS to Project Rendezvous Acquisition Corporation ("PRAC"), a Delaware Corporation. DMS and PRAC signed a stock purchase agreement on February 6, 2012 with the goal of completing the transaction by February 29, 2012. DMS wishes to notify and/or amend License #40-32477-01 to reflect such change.

DMS would appreciate anything your office can do to expedite its review of this matter. We believe expedited approval is appropriate in view that the stock sale will have no effect on DMS operations or personnel relevant to its radioactive materials license.   - A. Description of the transaction:

DMS Health Technologies, ("DMS") is the holder of the above-referenced NRC radioactive material license. Varistar Corporation, a Minnesota company, owns all of the stock of DMS. Varistar Corporation is proposing to sell 100% of its stock ownership in DMS to Project Rendezvous Acquisition Corporation ("PRAC"), a Delaware Corporation. PRAC's official address is 360 North Crescent Drive, South Building, Beverly Hills, California 90210.

DMS and PRAC signed a purchase agreement on February 6, 2012 with the goal of completing the sale no later than February 21, 2012. The following applies to the activities governed by DMS' radioactive naterial license:

- There will be no change in DMS' corporate structure, name, or status.
- Nothing on the face of DMS' current RAM license will change.
- None of the assets, business or operations of DMS itself will change in the transaction.
- No changes in personnel or duties are planned or expected.
- No changes in the organization, location, facilities, equipment, or procedures are planned or expected.
- No change in the surveillance program is planned or expected.
- No facilities will be decommissioned and all records concerning each facility will remain with DMS as applicable.
- As the party acquiring 100% of the stock of DMS, PRAC will assume the same level of responsibility for the RAM license(s) as was held by Varistar Corporation.


