As an Electrical Engineer, who has studied Nuclear Engineering, I would like to add my comments: As Beyond Nuclear board member Judith Johnsrud has long argued, the radioactive waste problem is "transsolutional," a problem beyond our ability to solve. Nuclear power must be abolished. We must stop making radioactive waste in the first place. As shown by the "Mountain of Radioactive Waste 70 Years High," prevention is the only real solution for radioactive waste.

For existing waste, NRC should require <u>Hardened On-Site Storage (HOSS)</u> to safeguard high-level radioactive waste against accidents, secure it against attacks, and prevent leakage over time into the environment. HOSS would require fortifications and the highest quality assurance and control. Hundreds of environmental groups across the U.S. have endorsed HOSS.
