On January 5, 2012, we responded to you with the following email:

Mr. Hankins,

With regard to the two Notice of Violations (NOVs) that you received, you are still required to provide NRC a reply to each NOV, even if you terminate your license.

With regard to your request to terminate your license, you should send a letter, signed by yourself, to

Division of Nuclear Material Safety

King of Prussia, PA 19406

And formally request termination of your NRC license. Be sure to include your License Number (i.e., 52-25629-01) and your Docket number (i.e., 03036301). You will need to include a completed NRC Form 314 which is available from the NRC website at

<http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/forms/nrc314info.html>.

You will need to show that the sources that were possessed by you in an area under NRC jurisdiction (e.g., Wyoming and Texas), were transferred to an authorize recipient (e.g., Texas Licensee). You will also need to demonstrate that the areas where you possessed NRC licensed materials were not impacted by your possession of the sources. Because your devices contained sealed sources, you can meet this requirement by providing leak test results for the sources that you recently possessed under your NRC license (e.g., while working under reciprocity in Texas and during storage in Wyoming). We also request that the recipient of these sources confirm that they indeed received the sources.
