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SUBJECT: MAY 15, 2012, SUMMARY OF CATEGORY 3 PUBLIC MEETING
ON FUEL CYCLE OVERSIGHT PROCESS PROJECT PLAN
DEVELOPMENT

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff held a Category 3 public meeting on May 15, 2012, to discuss the development of the Fuel Cycle Oversight Process (FCOP) Project Plan at the Executive Boulevard Building in Rockville, Maryland. The NRC staff utilized both a webinar and a teleconference brideline to maximize stakeholder participation and engagement. The discussion topics included assumptions, major milestones, tasks, timeline, resources, and stakeholder involvement.

The NRC staff who participated in this meeting included those from the Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards, the Office of Enforcement, the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation, the Office of New Reactors, the Office of Nuclear Security and Incident Response, and the Region II Office.

The meeting was useful in facilitating dialogs with the Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI) and industry representatives on the aforementioned topics. On the basis of the discussions, the NEI and industry representatives were able to better understand the status of various issues, especially those of interest to the industry stakeholders. The NRC staff will consider the feedback provided by NEI and the industry in developing its FCOP Project Plan in response to the staff requirements memorandum for-SECY-11-0140. No staff decisions were made during the meeting. In some cases, the staff provided clarification on the status of various ongoing issues related to the discussion topics.
