I am writing to ask you not to relicense Indian Point. I live in Rockland County, across the river, 1/2 mile outside the evacuation zone.

The evacuation "plan" is clearly unworkable. Years ago Governor Pataki commissioned a special study by James Lee Witt, former head of the NRC, which concluded that the evacuation plan is impossible. The county executives consistently refuse to certify. Common sense tells you that this is the Emperor's New Clothes – the plan is only an idea, on paper. A real evacuation in an emergency would be disastrous.

Indian Point is in close proximity to the most densely populated area of the United States. This plant would *never* be sited there today.

The energy from this plant is *not* **essential.** We can replace it with energy efficiency, conservation, and renewable energy from New York State.

The impact on the Hudson River and even on Atlantic coastal fisheries is significant. Even with wedgewire, entrainment will continue to kill the smallest organisms at the bottom of the food chain and juvenile fish.
