ATTACHMENT RADIOLOGICAL REMEDIATION SHALLOW LAND DISPOSAL AREA (SLDA) PARKS TOWNSHIP, PENNSYLVANIA

(Amendment 2 September 4, 2012 to Control No. 577083)

Cabrera Services, Inc. (CABRERA) is performing radiological remediation of the Shallow Land Disposal Area (SLDA) located in Parks Township, Armstrong County, Pennsylvania. This remediation is being completed under the USACE's Formerly Utilized Sites Remedial Action Program (FUSRAP) which was established to identify, investigate, and clean up or control sites previously used by the Atomic Energy Commission (AEC) and its predecessor, the Manhattan Engineer District (MED). Gamma spectroscopy systems using non-exempt radioactive sources will be utilized to calibrate sample analysis equipment used at the Site. Additionally, air monitoring systems (iCAMs) will be calibrated and daily source checked with an NRC non-exempt source.

This amendment 2 revises the completion date from July 31, 2012 to November 30, 2012 to address emergent Site issues associated with certain sensitive materials present on the site. No additional Site excavation work is expected to occur during the revised time period addressed by this amendment.

No other changes are made by this amendment from the scope of work and notification as provided to the NRC by CABRERA notification, March 1, 2012, Control No. 577083. Details associated with the radioactive sources used on the site remain unchanged. The Site is secure with respect to the CABRERA radioactive sources used to support Site activities and during time periods when CABRERA personnel are not on-site.

This information is being transmitted to you as required by condition 18A of the CABRERA Materials License.
