# Petition for Rulemaking Submitted by C-10 Research and Education Foundation, Inc.: Petition for Rulemaking; Partial Consideration in the Rulemaking Process; 10 CFR Part 72 (PRM-72-6; NRC-2008-0649)

On October 16, 2012, the NRC published a document in the *Federal Register* (77 FR 63254) notifying the public of the receipt of a petition for rulemaking (PRM). The PRM, dated November 24, 2008, was filed by Sandra Gavutis, Executive Director for C-10 Research and Education Foundation, Inc. (the petitioner). The PRM was docketed by the NRC and assigned Docket No. PRM-72-6. The petitioner requests the NRC amend its regulations concerning dry cask safety, security, transferability, and longevity. The petitioner made 12 requests. The NRC is denying nine of the petitioner's requests, but will consider one request in the rulemaking process. Action on two requests is being reserved for future rulemaking determinations, as these requests are currently under consideration by the NRC. The NRC will publish another *Federal Register* notice to inform the public of the Commission's decision for these two requests. The docket for this PRM will remain open until action is taken on the two remaining requests.

## Workshop hosted by the Digital Service Innovation Center and Chief Information Officer (CIO) Council

# Publication of Regulatory Guide 1.52, "Design, Inspection, and Testing Criteria for Air Filtration and Adsorption Units of Post-Accident Engineered-Safety-Feature Atmosphere Cleanup Systems in Light-Water-Cooled Nuclear Power Plants"

On October 3, 2012 the staff published Revision 4 of Regulatory Guide (RG) 1.52, "Design, Inspection, and Testing Criteria for Air Filtration and Adsorption Units of Post-Accident Engineered-Safety-Feature Atmosphere Cleanup Systems in Light-Water-Cooled Nuclear Power Plants." This regulatory guide provides a method that the NRC considers acceptable to implement part 50 of Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations (10 CFR), "Domestic Licensing of Production and Utilization Facilities," Appendix A, "General Design Criteria for Nuclear Power Plants," as it applies to the design, inspection, and testing of air filtration and iodine adsorption units of engineered-safety-feature atmosphere cleanup systems in light-water-cooled nuclear power plants.
