The Regional Assistance Committee has completed the review of the updated Illinois Plan for Radiological Accidents (IPRA) – Clinton, Volume VIII, dated 03/13, site specific to the Clinton Power Station. A line in the left margin indicates all changes made since the 11/11 update.

The following changes were made since the draft plan was submitted for review:

- The DeWitt County EOC floor plan was updated
- Sub-Area Population Map was updated
- Updated Chapter 3 – Sheltering Guide; Appendix D – Reception Centers and Shelters; and Appendix E – Sheltering Profiles to show Eisenhower High School in Macon County to be temporarily unavailable while they undergo renovations
- Changed ICC Command and Control position title for 24-hour staffing from ICC Chairman to ICC's Homeland Security Director

The Concept of Operations for the State of Illinois and DeWitt County as outlined in the 11/11 IPRA – Clinton have not changed. The plan has been found to conform to Title 44 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 350, and the requirements in NUREG-0654/FEMA-REP-1. Enclosed is the final printing of the document dated 03/13, and accompanying maps. All other copies of this plan should be destroyed.
