Plant Performance 2012

- **Operated Safely and Reliably in 2012**
 - Station Event Free Clock - Best Ever Performance: Currently 790 days (and counting)
 - Over 9 million person hours (and counting) without a Lost Time Accident
 - OSHA VPP STAR Worksite Recertification
 - Forced Loss Rate was zero for 2012
 - National Nuclear Accrediting Board renewed accreditation of Operations Training in Sept. 2012
 - Recertified to the ISO 14001 (environmental management) standards in July 2012
 - Approximately \$300,000 Contributed Annually to Charitable Organizations
