Senior Executive Service Candidate Development Program (SESCDP) Leadership Training

On August 25, 2014, Interagency Agreement Number NRC-HQ-84-14-I-0010 was awarded to the Office of Personnel Management's (OPM) Center for Leadership Development, Shepherdstown, West Virginia. The agreement will provide for off-site leadership training to be conducted at OPM's Eastern Management Development Center for the next SESCDP class. Issuance of Limerick Final Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement

On August 27, 2014, the staff issued the Final Supplement 49 to NUREG-1437, "Generic Environmental Impact Statement for License Renewal of Nuclear Plants: Limerick Generating Station, Units 1 and 2." The final supplemental environmental impact statement (FSEIS) represents the completion of the staff's environmental review of the license renewal application submitted by Exelon Generation Company. The FSEIS contains the NRC staff's preliminary conclusion that the impacts would not preclude renewing the plant's licensees for an additional 20 years.
