The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC or the staff) and representatives of NextEra Energy Seabrook, LLC (NextEra or the applicant), held a telephone conference call on September 30, 2014, to discuss and clarify the applicant's responses to staff requests for additional information (RAIs), which were submitted by the applicant dated April 14, 2011, August 11, 2011 and June 24, 2014. Specifically, the applicant confirmed that inspections of the containment liner plate in April 2011, were performed in accordance with the augmented examination requirements of IWE 1241(a), and prior to a subsequent review that determined that the areas were incorrectly designated for augmented examination. Additionally, the applicant clarified the response to RAI B.2.1.31A-3 dated May 15, 2014, regarding the transition from "Tier 2 - qualitative" monitoring of cracks less than .05mm to "Tier 2 - quantitative" monitoring if the cracks are found to exceed .05mm. As part of this discussion, the applicant agreed to provide further clarification in a supplement to its RAI B.2.1.31A-3 response dated May 15, 2014.
