By letter dated July 14, 2014 (Reference 2) Duke Energy requested additional time to evaluate TSTF-523. In addition, reference 2 included a regulatory commitment to complete the evaluation of TSTF-523 and submit a letter to the NRC providing a schedule for submittal of a License Amendment Request (LAR) by October 15, 2014.

Based on the results of the evaluation, Catawba will submit a LAR to adopt TSTF-523 by June 30, 2015, as described in the attachment. The LAR will include a description of any deviations from the generic TS changes provided in TSTF-523.
