SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF NRC RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE NO. 05-14892-01

By letter dated August 11, 2014, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency National Enforcement Investigations Center informed the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) that you wished to terminate your NRC radioactive materials license. The NRC Form 314 dated August 11, 2014, stated that all radioactive material used as calibration standards had been disposed using a waste contractor.

The supporting documentation to the NRC Form 314 also provided a copy of the final radiation survey. The NRC staff has reviewed the supporting documentation to your NRC Form 314. Based on the documentation submitted and a review of your historical file, the staff concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from the facility and the facility located at Building 25, Denver Federal Center, Denver, CO, 80225-0227, is suitable for unrestricted use in accordance with 10 CFR 20.1402, "Radiological Criteria for Unrestricted Use." Based on these conclusions, no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required.

Please find enclosed Amendment Number 25 to License Number 05-14892-01 authorizing your license termination. An environmental assessment for this action is not required since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(20)(iii).
